Directions

75 miles from Columbus, OH; 160 miles from Cincinnati; 45 miles from Parkersburg, WV; at the junction of US Routes 33 and 50. Follow Route 33 to exit 17 for Route 682 North (Ohio University), follow the traffic circle south onto Richland Ave., turn right at the first street, Dairy Lane. The Dairy Barn is less than a mile.
