Studio Rules for Minor and Parent/Guardians

- Minor must be signed in and out by parent or guardian. No person under 18 is permitted to be dropped off outside the Dairy Barn!
- Parent or guardian contact number is correct and parent or guardian will keep their cell phone on their person while minor is in the studio.
- Minor may only be in studio without adult during "Free-Style" Times on *Seconds and Thirds* Saturday Open Studios 3:00-5:00.
- Minors are expected to maintain appropriate behavior *and*
 - * Be respectful towards Studio Commander and all studio participants.
 - * Will not abuse art materials and only use them as directed.
 - * Will refrain from fowl language or negative comments to other participants.
 - * Will remain in studio until signed out by parent or guardian with the exception of using the restroom.
- Minor are authorized by parent or guardian to use either their pre-paid "cash cow card" or cash to pay for project costs before leaving the Barn. Parent or guardians may also pay at the end of a studio session with a check. Managing costs or setting spending limits is not the responsibility of the Studio Commander or any Dairy Barn Staff.
- Minor will dress in studio appropriate clothing which can get dirty or stained. The Dairy Barn and Staff are not responsible for damage to clothing.
- Minor will only use equipment and materials the studio commander has authorized.
- Parent or guardian will pick up minor by 5:00pm
- Failure by either minor or parent/guardian to follow the rules may result in being disinvited to participate in Open Studios

\$\$\$ Project Costs and Options For Open Studios

“Free Style” time during open studios means that participants can acquire art materials more or less A la Cart from the studio and make their own projects. Only people who are studio certified are permitted to work on the pottery wheels. In order for minor to qualify, they must complete an introductory pottery class through the Barn (ages 16 and up) or be able to prove to the Studio Commander that they already know the basics of throwing. The Studio Commander can help teach participants other skills like hand building and glazing and how to plan their clay or paint projects. The cost of free style projects varies primarily based on amount and type of materials. The cost for ceramics projects takes into account clay, glaze, and firing costs. Costs are roughly calculated to be about \$5 per half pound of clay. A half pound of clay is about the size of a fist. Most projects will fall in this range. Minor participants can bring cash or pre-purchased “cash cow punch cards” are available for \$50.00 and recommended for minor participants. That way they can just punch as they go and parents can limit spending.
