

Materials List for Beginning Painting with Erica Magnus

Please Note: During the first class session, students will see a series of demonstrations and have the opportunity to sample each medium. The paints and materials for this will be provided by the Dairy Barn. However for the second session and beyond, participants will need to come to class with their own materials. Participants who already have oil and/or acrylics paintings supplies please bring one or both along with the painting supplies listed.

These materials will be available for use at the Dairy Barn however you are encouraged to bring your own if you have them

- Table easels, drawing benches some standing easels
- Some containers for oil and acrylic paints
- Some cleanup supplies

You will need to bring a minimum of 3 basic paints to each class and preferably the first class

- Ultramarine Blue
- Alizarin Crimson
- Yellow Ochre

Required Materials (for class sessions 2-8). Each week the Instructor will let participants know precisely what they will need for following week:

- 1 pre-stretched canvas 11" x 14"
- Palette Paper 8x10 or larger, several sheets
- 4 canvas boards 8" x 10" (smaller is fine) – at least 4, possibly more as announced
- 3 bristle brushes
- Flat, Bright, Filbert, (your favorite type or one of each as you choose) Sizes # 4, 8, 10, (or 12)
- 1 palette knife (metal)
- Palette or palette paper
- Odorless turpentine or turpenoid for oil paints (NO TURPENTINE)

- Paints (same colors for both oil and acrylic)*
 - Titanium White
 - Cadmium Yellow Pale (or Light)
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Burnt Umber
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cerulean Blue Hue (or phthalo Blue)
 - Viridian (or phthalo Green)
 - Alizarin Crimson
- Linseed oil or acrylic medium

Notes:

- If you have/buy a set of 10 or more paints you have what you need, even if they include different colors.
- We will not be using oil (ie linseed oil) or acrylic mediums (ie gloss matte) for the first few classes

Recommended:

- A painting shirt or smock (one you don't mind getting stained)
- Painting gloves if you wish
- Rags
