Many supplies are locally available at the College Book Store, JoAnn's, Walmart or can be ordered online via Amazon, or dickblick.com

- Drawing pad – either 11x14” or 12x18” recommended. Should be 80 lb or higher (paper weight on cover) and make sure to check texture for preference *(feel paper before buying if possible) – Pad Should have at least 20 sheets.

Helpful hint: “cold press” = “tooth” or bumpy texture

“hot press” = smooth or smoother than cold press

Note: any sketch pad you already have even if smaller (i.e. use materials you already own!)

- Dry drawing mediums
 - Minimum of three (different softness) black & white drawing tools of your choice such as charcoal sticks or charcoal pencils (medium, soft, softer)
 - Graphite pencils or graphite sticks 2B or softer *
*recommended from 3B, 4B, 6B, 8B range
- Eraser (avoid kneaded type)
 - choose those recommended for charcoal or graphite drawing tools (example): Staedtler or Factic soap eraser

Recommended

- a small sketchbook for quick studies of people (example): 5” X 7” or 6” X 9”
- old clothes you do not mind getting dirty or work shirt “smock”
- old cloth rag (cotton preferred)
