The Story Shirt Challenge: A Contemporary Quilt & Textile Artists' Challenge with Danette Pratt

The Dairy Barn is excited to offer a contemporary art quilt challenge to any artist that desires to create an art quilt that utilizes the challenge title. This is the Dairy Barns' first art quilt challenge and hopes that it provides a unique individualistic and artistic venue for textile artists. Past QN entrants are encouraged to apply to this Dairy Barn exclusive studio driven, textile art challenge! The finished quilt will be exhibited in sequence to the opening of The Dairy Barns' Quilt National '19, in May 2019. The artists will finish their work in a 5-day studio that will include indigo and / or eco dying opportunities, embellishments including stenciling, fabric paint and photo transfer, exhibit design and installation of their final work.

Movement & Light: Additions for Art Quilts with Marianne Williamson

Art comes alive when light and movement are the focus of an artist's work. When attention is given to values and composition, to bring the viewer into the work, other senses can be awakened. A smell, a touch, the feeling of cold, or weightlessness, or a cacophony of sound can all be shared through a piece. I would like the participant to add more to their piece than design, but the century old principals of dark, medium and light, size of shapes, and repetition through the work are explored. Participants will use raw edge appliqué, free motion quilting, stencils, paint, Sharpies, and other techniques that they choose, to make the work come alive to touch, with even the illusion of smell and sound! You can change details and even the main elements with paint to add freedom, light and movement. In 2 days the participant will learn many new techniques to add movement and light to their own art quilts.

Hand Stitching According to Terrie Mangat:

Discover the art of slow stitching to express your ideas in fabric. In this class learn Terrie's favorite hand stitching techniques; try out her favorite, reverse appliqué, as well as her Kentucky inspired hand piecing technique. In addition to these favored techniques, learn the 'main squeeze' hand stitches: buttonhole stitch, shesha mirrors by hand, stem stitch, & feather stitch. She will also discuss her favorite tools, and why they are so useful to her. Go home with a technique sampler.

Origami Modules & Boxes with Ellen Oppenheimer

Ellen learned origami from her grandmother Lillian Oppenheimer who started Origami USA, wrote origami books and was instrumental in popularizing origami in the USA. Ellen has been teaching Origami to elementary school students for 15 years. As quilters who love color and geometry, you will find folding modules to be very compelling and rewarding. This workshop will teach some of her favorite folds that are accessible and beautiful. You will come away knowing the skills and techniques to make origami modular boxes, polyhedrons and stars.

Learn an original technique that allows for the SEAM-LESS integration of aged print on various types of cloth. Find out how to add hidden lettering on cloth and design with INC –infused newsprint cloth.

You will learn how to make screens 2 different ways. A presentation will introduce you to cutting machines and the program that Margarita uses and she will demonstrate how to do it economically by hand. No sewing involved in this workshop! You will end up with soft, washable, pliable and easy to sew Art-cloth. Bring your sense of adventure and be prepared for serendipity results!

A Sense of Place: with Jean Wells Keenan

Is there a place that is very special to you or that you are in complete awe of? Maybe it is the colors, or a setting, or the ambiance, whatever it is- that will be the starting point. In this workshop you will work from this inspiration to create three to four small pieces that begin by focusing on color. Students will be exposed to rule-less piecing techniques, several composition exercises, color studies, working from inspirational photographs, principles of design and how they apply in the design process. Working in a series, students will make three small studies, then create a larger wall hanging. Jean's books *Intuitive Color and Design 2nd edition* and *Journey to Inspired Art Quilting* are good references.

Designing the Surface with Kevin Womack

Have you longed to create your own fabrics, but don't know where to start? Join Kevin as he guides you through a series of easy steps in designing with fabric paints. Start by sampling the effects of transparent, opaque and metallic paints and move on to utilizing a multitude of methods to create original fabric designs. Each day, you will build layers of design as you add to your technique toolbox. Emphasis will be placed on creating cohesive compositions. Covered will be a variety of techniques including printing with found objects, creating your own stamps, working with silkscreens, batik with soy wax, gelatin plate mono-printing and more. Join in the fun as we play, experiment and explore design.

Machine Quilting: the Basics & Beyond with Sandra Palmer Ciolino

This 2-day machine quilting workshop is designed for beginning machine quilters as well as quilters with machine quilting experience who wish to review basic techniques and sharpen their skills. Participants will learn to prepare their stations and machines for quilting, adjust machine tension, and choose suitable quilting threads and needles. The majority of the workshop will be spent becoming familiar with and stitching a variety of walking foot and free-motion machine quilting designs and motifs: linear, grid, meander, texture/filler, focal, echo, and channel – on layered quilt samplers or on small quilts, if desired. Plenty of class time will be devoted to developing and practicing designs and motifs that most interest you and are appropriate for the style of quilts you enjoy creating.

Dyeing the Color Wheel with Daren Redman

Daren Redman will be teaching this hands-on class with Procion MX fiber reactive dyes. Students will be dyeing provided cottons in 1/2 yard lengths in zip-loc bags on a table inside the fiber studio. They will work from recipe cards to create red, blue, yellow, green, orange and purple fabric to take home to use in wall art, home decor projects or wearables. While the fabrics are setting, Daren will lecture about the dyeing process, how to wash out the fabrics at home and explain her hand-dyeing resources. Students will take home six beautiful hand-dyed fabrics, which they created themselves, in this workshop.
