Beginning Oil Painting – Basic Materials List

Suggested Oil Paints:

- *Cadmium Yellow Light
- Hansa Yellow Medium
- *Cadmium Red Medium
- *Alizarin Crimson
- *Ultramarine Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- *Ultramarine Violet
- *Phthalo Green
- Viridian Green
- Sap Green
- *Yellow Ochre
- *Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Ivory Black
- *Titanium White
- *Neutral Grey

Any other colors that catch your eye!

*You should get at the very least these colors to make do with in the class

**Instructor recommended brand: Gamblin 1980 student grade oil paints; but any decent oil paint will do

Brushes:

Flat, Bright, or Filbert, (your favorite type or one of each as you choose): Sizes 2, 4, 8, 10
(you will need at least 1 Flat, preferably size 4, for blending)

Size 4 Fan brush

Other Materials:

8 oz. solvent- Gamasol or **odorless** mineral spirits

Gamblin Galkyd medium

2 small glass jars with lids- (baby food or salsa jars will work)

5 8x10 canvas boards

1 stretched canvas in a size of your choosing for your final project
