SUPPLY LIST:

Class #1 Basic oil paints (minimum) **to bring to first class**

3 primary paint colors (minimum)

- Ultramarine Blue (cool color)
- Cadmium Yellow (warm color)
- Cadmium Red (warm color)

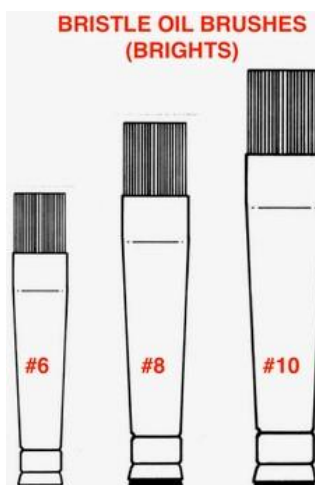
Recommended for course: Basic BLICK Studio set of 12 tubes

There are other good brands but these are suggested by Dairy Barn for

- Affordability
- consistently reliable quality. (*Avoid the very cheap oil paints*)

Always bring to class:

- an easel and small folding table for palette.
- a stool or folding chair if you prefer not to stand
- 2 canvases approximate size: 11" X 14" (*good start*) no bigger than 14" X 17"
- pre-stretched canvases best
- canvas boards have some disadvantages; less receptive to working the paint
- palette (*can be a tray, dish, or other homemade type; paints show up best on white*)
- 2 bristle oil paint brushes (*stiffer--no acrylics brushes; too soft for applying oil paints so avoid those "good for both" packaged brushes*)



- Brights preferred for landscape (*usually labeled # 8, #10, or #12*)
- look for sizes that measure: 1/2" wide and 1" wide (*a great start*)
- bring your own favorite brush sizes as the class progresses
- odorless turpentine (*do not bring mineral spirits; it's best for housepainter's brush cleaning*)
- 2 containers for odorless turpentine; Dairy Barn has some to borrow
- 1 for brush cleaning during class
- 1 for clean turpentine to use as a thinning medium
- several rags (*cotton best- old T-shirts better than terry cloth, synthetic fabrics don't work as well*)
- 1 palette knife (*flexible metal recommended*)

- oil paints (*Sets have a good range of these, but feel free to buy singly if preferred*)
- *All colors below found in the BLICK Studio set of 12, except Pthalo Green*
 - Cadmium Yellow Pale (or Light, or Lemmon)
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cerulean Blue (or Pthalo Blue)
 - Sap Green
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Burnt Umber
 - Raw Umber
 - Titanium White
 - Ivory Black
 - (Pthalo Green)

Recommended clothing:

- Painting shirt, smock. or old clothes you don't mind getting stained.
- A hat for sun if weather requires it.
- Water bottle for hydration
