

A Dozen Ways: Design for Art Quilts with Pat Pauly Quilt National 2021 Workshop

Tools & Materials List: (participants are responsible for providing their own materials from this list)

Tools:

- Small cutting mat
- Rotary cutter: with a sharp blade, and a spare one.
- Sewing machine
- Your usual sewing supplies (including thread)
- Fabric Scissors
- Paper Scissors
- Iron and ironing board or ironing surface
- Basic sewing foot (do not use a 1/4" foot with an edge)

Materials:

- Glue stick
- Thin line black sharpie, medium line black sharpie
- Three printed photos (of yours, or you have the right to use) printed on regular paper or photo paper in a size between 4 x 6 and 8 x 10
- 6 transparent page protectors (like you use in a three ring binder)
- 10 blank pages of copy paper
- 4 sheets tracing paper 8 ½ x 11 or similar size
- 6 postcards (used from mail) or 6- 3 x 5 or 4 x 6 index cards

Fabrics:

- 2 Quart-sized bags of fabric scraps randomly added
- ½ Yard of muslin or plain light fabric
- ¼ yard of black or dark fabric
- Variety of fat quarters, at least a dozen, which we will use about half. This should be a good range from light to dark.

Inspirational Material:

- Old calendar (we will use the photos)
- Three printed photos (of yours, or you have the right to use) printed on regular paper or photo paper in a size between 4 x 6 and 8 x 10

For sketching:

- Notebook or small sketchbook.
- Pencil, eraser, pencil sharpener; colored pencils (about 6-8).



- Notebook and pen, and anything else you think you may need.

A day or so before class I will send you a PDF via email of supporting materials for you to print which is about 8 – 10 pages.
