

Shibori & Stitched Techniques for Indigo Dyeing with Sandy Shelenberger Quilt National 2021 Workshop

Provided Materials – Included in Kit:

- All dye materials and use of shapes and clamps
- Special thread for the hand-stitched shibori that glides and is strong enough to gather
- All tools for shibori techniques
- One Scarf and two yards of cotton fabric

Additional Fabrics:

- The artist will have additional scarves and yardage available for purchase, prices will depend upon the type of scarf/fabric selected.
- Students who find they have enough time are welcome to dye more fabric/scarves. You may bring extra fabrics - silk, cotton, linen or rayon if desired. Can be patterned fabric that you wish to change by overdyeing in Indigo.
- You may also bring an article of clothing/accessory you wish to upcycle with shibori techniques. This will be done after everyone has had a chance to use the Indigo.

Tools & Materials List (Tools attendees should bring):

- Sturdy rubber gloves
- An apron or paint shirt
- 2-plastic bowls or 1-gallon buckets (ice cream buckets work nicely) to carry wet or dyed items
- Plastic bags to take home your projects to be washed (Gallon Zip Lock bags work well)
- Means of identifying your work – small beads, ribbon, buttons etc. to sew or safety pin on your fabric
- Small pair of sharp scissors
- Seam ripper
- Basting or embroidery needles (sharp point)
- 1-2 balls of very strong string of natural fiber - cotton string or sturdy bakers twine works well. (I found at Tractor Supply and Ace Hardware)
- *Optional: One plastic cylinder (PVC pipe) up to 2 feet in length– (*Optional, as I have several PVC cylinders to use during class) These can be purchased at Lowes or Hardware stores in cut lengths. 2”, 3”, 4” and 6” diameters can be chosen.
- Notebook and pen, and anything else you think you may need.
