

Painting Class Materials List

For the first Painting Class meeting, students are asked to bring...

- 2 small [pre-stretched canvases](#) sizes 8" X 10" or 9" X 12" ([canvas panels](#) not recommended)
- 1 or more cloth paint rags (old T-shirts work well)
- A paint shirt or smock to protect clothing

At the **first class only** students will be provided...

- Oil paints
- Bristle oil brushes
- Turpenoid paint thinner
- Containers for paint thinner (these will be provided for all classes in the session)

During the first Painting Class, the instructor will...

- Outline proper care and maintenance of painting materials
- Discuss specific properties of paint, materials, brushes and other accessories
- Give several short painting exercises to get students started
- And an opportunity for Q&A

For the remaining classes of the session, students will provide their own supplies. This arrangement allows students to acquire the materials they prefer after trying things out in the first class. In addition, The Dairy Barn will provide an opportunity at the end of the first class for students to purchase their preferred materials from [Blick.com](#) with no shipping costs.

- Students are welcome to use oil paints and brushes they already own
- Students may also use their own acrylic paints and brushes if they prefer
- The instructor will be able to consult on materials recommendations and suggestions
- Any ordered supplies will be available for students at the start of the second class
- Students who order supplies through The Dairy Barn will receive a separate invoice payable online
