

Drawing Class Materials List

This class will use dry black drawing mediums such as...

- Graphite pencil
- Charcoal pencil
- Compressed or vine charcoal
- Conte crayon

(No color or wet mediums will be used. If you are interested in the use of color and how it can effectively be used to create form and value, you may be interested in our Painting Class with Erica Magnus.)

What to bring to the first class:

- Yourself and your interest in drawing!
- Your preferred dry black medium from the ones listed above
- You will need at least three hardnesses to create different values.
For example a 2B, 4B and 8B drawing pencil
Medium or soft compressed charcoal
- Drawing pad measuring at least 9" x 12" but not larger than 18" x 24"
11" x 14" recommended
Mixed media surface (slightly textured) at least 70 lb. weight (90 lb. weight or higher is recommended)
- Hand wipes; useful during and after class
- Old shirt to protect your clothes

If you are unsure of what medium or paper you prefer, The Dairy Barn will supply an assortment of the materials listed above and erasers to experiment with in the first class. At the end of the first class, The Dairy Barn extends an opportunity for students to purchase their preferred materials from [Blick.com](https://www.blick.com) with no shipping costs.
